## **Answers**

### Task 1

(00.00 - 01.26)

The Shona people are the largest tribe in Zimbabwe. They have very specific beliefs about <u>death</u>. For example, a 'bad' death is one which was caused with evil intentions, for example a <u>murder</u>. Someone who causes a bad death must be punished so that the dead person can rest. Therefore, a Zimbabwean audience sees <u>Hamlet's father</u> as the victim of a bad death, and they understand that <u>Hamlet</u> has a duty to find out what happened and try to put it right.

#### (01.27 - 3.42)

About one-third of Zimbabwean people live outside Zimbabwe. When they come back to Zimbabwe, for a visit, they need to find out what's been happening while they were <u>away</u>. It's <u>important</u> not to form opinions or make decisions too quickly. Therefore, from a Zimbabwean perspective, it's <u>understandable</u> that Hamlet takes a long time to find out about his father's death and take action. In contrast, Western audiences and actors sometimes feel that Hamlet is too <u>slow</u> to act.

Tonderai's company performed 'Hamlet' in Zimbabwe and South Africa. In Zimbabwe, they started the play with a traditional <u>funeral</u> procession, to make people think about death. The audience slowly learned how evil Hamlet's <u>uncle</u> is. They were shocked at the scene where Hamlet questions his <u>mother</u> in her bedroom.
